CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry

Are you about to start a career where you will need to have access to a construction worksite? Then the law states you must have a valid White Card.

COURSE OVERVIEW

White Card is a term used to describe the plastic card issued by NT Worksafe through the Territory Business Centre indicating that a person has undertaken general construction induction training (GCIT)

This is a course of training that provides basic knowledge of construction work, the Work Health and Safety (WHS) laws that apply, common hazards likely to be encountered in construction work and how the associated risks can be controlled.

Under WHS legislation, workers on construction sites in Australia must undertake general construction induction training or 'White Card training' and have evidence of their attendance from the course before they are permitted to commence work on a construction site.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Identify WHS legislative requirements
- Identify construction hazards and control measures
- Identify WHS communication and reporting processes
- Identify WHS incident response procedures

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment*.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one day (minimum 6 hours).

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently in Alice Springs and Darwin.

White Card can also be delivered regionally – please contact the NT office for more details.

Civil Train can come to your worksite to deliver White Card training to a group of employees – please contact the office for a quote.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

To be deemed competent in this course, learners are required to **communicate** and **comprehend** the following for their White Card skills assessment:

- **Clarify** WHS legislative requirements
- **Verbally** report construction hazards and tasks
- **Ask** effective questions
- **Relay** information to others
- **Discuss** WHS issues and information
- **Explain** the basic OHS legislative requirements which will be applicable to own work
- **Explain** the meaning of safety signs and symbols
- **Identify** common construction hazards
- **Discuss** the basic principles of risk management.
