

WHITE CARD REFRESHER

CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry

Already hold a White Card, but need a refresher? Achieved your White Card interstate or online and require an SA card for your employer?

COURSE OVERVIEW

White Card is a term used to describe the plastic card issued by a Registered Training Organisations indicating that a person has undertaken general induction training for construction work.

This is a course of training that refreshes basic knowledge of construction work, the Work Health and Safety (WHS) laws that apply, common hazards likely to be encountered in construction work and how the associated risks can be controlled.

Under WHS legislation, workers on construction sites in Australia must undertake general induction training or 'White Card training' and have evidence of their attendance from the course before they are permitted to commence work on a construction site.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Identify WHS legislative requirements
- Identify construction hazards and control measures
- Identify WHS communication and reporting processes
- Identify WHS incident response procedures

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment and plastic SA White Card with your photograph with a new issue date.

COURSE DURATION

This course is a half day (minimum 3 hours).

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently at Civil Train SA offices in Thebarton and Port Augusta.

White Card is also delivered regionally – please contact the office for regional locations and dates.

Civil Train SA can come to your worksite to deliver White Card training to a group of employees – please contact the office for a quote.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Enclosed footwear is a minimum requirement for all Civil Train SA sites. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must already hold a White Card to be eligible to attend this course and this must be provided to the Trainer on the day.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course:

Numeracy Skills to:

• locate and recognise numbers commonly used in safety signs.

Oral communication skills to:

- ask questions to clarify instructions
- listen to instructions to identify key safety information
- tell another person about a construction problem or hazard

Reading skills to:

- follow simple pictorial safety instructions
- follow simple safety instructions that are written in English

Problem-solving skills to:

select risk control measures

Please note Civil Train SA only carries out assessments for White Card in English. If English is your second language, you may engage a professional and independent translator at your cost, for training purposes only. However, you will be required to undertake the assessment in English without the aid of your translator.

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.
