Are you working in an industry where you will need to work in a confined space? This course is recognised by industry, including the mining sector.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Working in confined spaces is a highly hazardous activity and is governed by various legislative instruments.

Confined spaces are commonly found in tanks, ducts, flues, chimneys, containers or other similar enclosed or partially enclosed structures. They pose dangers because they are usually not designed to be areas where people work. The hazards are not always obvious and may change with each entry into the confined space.

This course is based on applicable State legislation to provide you with the skills and knowledge to safely work in confined spaces and safely use breathing apparatus in confined spaces.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare for working in confined space
- Conduct pre-donning checks and tests on breathing apparatus
- Work in confined space
- Operate breathing apparatus
- Exit confined space
- Clean up and conclude operations

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment and plastic card to keep in your wallet to show competency.

Industry recommends both components of this course are renewed every two years.

COURSE DURATION

This course is two days (16 hours).

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face. Delivery of the two units of competency are clustered and therefore attendance of both days is compulsory.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently at Civil Train SA offices in Thebarton and Port Augusta.

Confined space and breathing apparatus is also delivered regionally – please contact the office for regional locations and dates.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Safety footwear, long pants and a long sleeved shirt is required. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.

You must be **clean shaven** on day two to undertake the breathing apparatus assessment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.
