GAS TEST ATMOSPHERES

MSMWHS217 Gas test atmospheres

Are you working in an industry with confined spaces? This course provides evidence you are competent to gas test atmospheres for those entering a confined space.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is appropriate for persons requiring the knowledge, skills and abilities to use gas detection equipment to test and monitor potentially hazardous atmospheres.

Testing involves the use of electronic test apparatus.

In a typical scenario an individual may be required to carry out gas testing of an atmosphere prior to entering a specific area or workspace.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Prepare for gas testing
- Test gas
- Maintain equipment

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment and plastic card to keep in your wallet to show competency.

Industry recommends this course is renewed every two years.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one day (8 hours).

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently at Civil Train SA offices in Thebarton and Port Augusta.

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PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Enclosed footwear is a minimum requirement for all Civil Train SA sites. Long pants and a long sleeved shirt is required. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear the correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

This course does not qualify a person to enter confined spaces for gas testing purposes. It is advisable that learners have completed RIIWHS202D Enter and work in confined spaces prior to enrolling in MSAPMOHS217A Gas Test Atmospheres.

Testing involves the use of electronic test apparatus.

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.
