### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

EWPs are powered mobile plant designed to lift or lower people and equipment to a work location, by means of a telescoping device or articulated device, beyond a base support.

This course trains and assesses in the operation of scissor (unrestricted) and/or boom type lifts (below the height of 11m).

This course satisfies the [SafeWork SA minimum training requirements](#) expected for workers who operate EWPs in accordance with the person conducting a business or undertaking's (PCBU) primary duty of care under the Work Health and Safety Act 2012.

### **COURSE OUTCOMES**

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare for operating an elevating work platform
- Conduct work activities from elevating work platform
- Carry out operator maintenance
- Clean up

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment and a wallet card which will identify whether you were assessed on Scissor lift or Boom lift.

### **COURSE DURATION**

This course is one day.

### **DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT**

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

### **LOCATION**

You must be 17 years or older to undertake this course. If you are under 17 years old, ask to speak to a representative.
