COURSE OVERVIEW

Work Zone Traffic Management involves the management of traffic through, around and past roadwork sites whilst balancing the safety needs of both workers and road users such as drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.

In South Australia, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) govern the safe undertaking of Work Zone Traffic Management.

This course has been designed specifically with traffic management companies to provide a pathway to employment in the sector.

COURSE CONTENT

Be immersed into the world of work zone traffic management!

Over five days build your skills and knowledge in the technical areas of setting up work zones and controlling traffic flow as well as implementing safety procedures, applying workplace communication techniques (using UHF radios, conflict resolution) and completing risk assessments.

The combination of units in the program also address the forthcoming national changes to Work Zone Traffic Management training, putting you at the forefront of Work Zone Traffic Management training.

COURSE OUTCOMES

This course is one week (five consecutive days).
