**Are you working or planning to work in traffic management? In NT, you need to be accredited by the Department of Infrastructure.**

### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

Work Zone Traffic Management (WZTM) involves the management of traffic through, around and past roadwork sites whilst balancing the safety needs of both workers and road users such as drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.

The Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR) issues the NT Work Zone Traffic Management ID cards on behalf of the Department of Infrastructure.

### **COURSE OUTCOMES**

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare
- Control Traffic
- Operate communication devices
- Set out the traffic guidance scheme
- Monitor traffic guidance scheme
- Close down traffic guidance scheme
- Clean up

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment for:

RIIWHS205D Control traffic with stop-slow bat  
RIIWHS302D Implement traffic management plan

This must then be presented to the Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR), who will issue the Work Zone Traffic Management Card for the Northern Territory. Additional fees may apply. See:

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## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

White Card

Current Australian Driver's Licence

Evidence of NT residency or information relating to current NT accommodation

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

The applicant must be able to use the English language at a level that is appropriate to:

- comply with written and verbal reporting requirements and procedures
- communicate clearly and concisely with others to receive and clarify work instructions
- communicate clearly and concisely with others to resolve coordination requirements prior to commencing and during work activities
- identify and select appropriate traffic guidance scheme from the Field Guide and implement
- apply legislative requirements
- describe the effects of travel speed and vehicle mass on stopping distances

**ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.**

## **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

Long pants, a long sleeved, hi-vis shirt, safety boots and a wide brimmed hat is required for the practical component of this course. Water and sunscreen will be provided. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.
