COURSE OVERVIEW

Work Zone Traffic Management involves the management of traffic through, around and past roadwork sites whilst balancing the safety needs of both workers and road users such as drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.

In South Australia, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) govern the safe undertaking of Work Zone Traffic Management.

At all times whilst workers are present at a worksite at least one worker must carry a Current Work Zone Traffic Management accreditation card.

COURSE OUTCOMES

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare
- Control Traffic
- Operate communication devices
- Set out the traffic guidance scheme
- Monitor traffic guidance scheme
- Close down traffic guidance scheme
- Clean up

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment and a DPTI issued Work Zone Traffic Management Card.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one day (9 hours).

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train SA recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

The applicant must be able to use the English language at a level that is appropriate to:

- comply with written and verbal reporting requirements and procedures
- communicate clearly and concisely with others to receive and clarify work instructions
- communicate clearly and concisely with others to resolve coordination requirements prior to commencing and during work activities
- identify and select appropriate traffic guidance scheme from the Field Guide and implement
- apply legislative requirements
- describe the effects of travel speed and vehicle mass on stopping distances

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Long pants and a long sleeved shirt, safety boots and hi-vis is required for the practical component of this course. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.
